

To Ms. Ellis:

The State Party has received your email correspondence dated May 27, 2017 (see attached), challenging the Statewide CDP Officer Elections for the Chair position which occurred at the State Convention May 19-21, 2017.

Your challenge was filed within 7-days of the election, but did not provide any factual basis for the challenge. In consultation with the Credentials Committee Lead Chair Michael Wagaman and the Rules Committee Lead Chair Garry Shay, and in the interests of fairness and notice, the Compliance Review Commission will grant an additional 7-days to submit the factual basis for the challenge.

The deadline to submit the aforementioned information is Thursday, June 8 at 5pm. We do note that the review of CDP materials was completed by the Ellis Campaign on Tuesday, May 30. You can submit your written testimony by emailing it to both Emma and myself.

The State Party has a process for dealing with such challenges through our Compliance Review Commission, a six member group made up of three members of our Rules Committee and three members of our Credentials Committee. In accordance with past practice, the information will then be distributed to all other candidates following its submission. Any written testimony/evidence by other interested parties in response to the challenge must be submitted by Monday, June 19 at 5pm. As soon as the CRC has reviewed all submitted written materials, they will deliberate and issue a written decision, which will be distributed to all interested parties.

As always, the CRC requests that your written submission be succinct.
