	Proposition 62 - THE JUSTICE THAT WORKS ACT OF 2016 Death penalty repeal. Replaces death penalty with life without parole sentences. Applies retroactively to people already sentenced to death.	Support
	Proposition 66 - DEATH PENALTY REFORM AND SAVINGS ACT OF 2016 Limits inmate appeals and expedites executions. Gives CA Dept. of Corrections & Rehab more latitude in housing condemned inmates and requires inmates to work, with 70% of their wages going to crime victims.	Oppose
	Proposition 54 - THE CALIFORNIA LEGISLATURE TRANSPARENCY ACT Prohibits legislature from passing any bill unless it has been in print and on the internet for at least 72 hours before a vote, except in emergency. Requires AV recordings of all Legislature proceedings made and posted on web. Allows recordings to be used for any legitimate purpose without any fees paid to State.	Authorize to oppose

	Proposition 64 - CONTROL, REGULATE AND TAX ADULT USE OF MARIJUANA ACT Legalizes marijuana and hemp under state law. State oversees licensing and regulation. Enacts 15% cultivation tax - medical cultivation exceptions.	Support
	Proposition 51 - KINDERGARTEN THROUGH COMMUNITY COLLEGE PUBLIC EDUCATION FACILITIES BOND ACT OF 2016 Authorizes and issues \$9 billion in bonds. Funds to be allocated for school facilities and community college capital outlay	Support
	Proposition 52 - CALIFORNIA MEDI-CAL HOSPITAL REIMBURSEMENT INITIATIVE Increases required vote to two-thirds for the Legislature to amend a certain existing law that imposes fees on hospitals (for purpose of obtaining federal Medi-Cal matching funds) and that directs those fees and federal matching funds to hospital-provided Medi-Cal health care services, to uncompensated care provided by hospitals to uninsured patients, and to children's health coverage.	Support
	CHARITABLE HOSPITAL EXECUTIVE COMPENSATION ACT OF 2016 Cap nonprofit hospital (including affiliated foundations, groups and physicians' groups) executives' pay. Penalties include fines, revocation of tax-exempt status, appointment of state Attorney General's office representative to violating nonprofit's board.	Support
	Proposition 60 - THE CALIFORNIA SAFER SEX IN THE ADULT FILM INDUSTRY ACT Requires condoms and other protective measures to be used during making of pornographic films, as well as requiring pornography producers to pay for certain health testing, vaccines and checkups.	Oppose
	Proposition 61 - CALIFORNIA DRUG PRICE RELIEF INITIATIVE Prohibits state agencies from paying more for a prescription drug than the lowest price paid for the same drug the US Dept of Veterans Affairs. Applies to any program where the state is the ultimate payer for a drug, even if the state does not purchase the drug directly. Exempts certain purchases of prescription drugs funded through Medi-Cal.	No Position
	Proposition 59 - OVERTURN CITIZENS UNITED ADVISORY QUESTION Asks whether elected officials should “use all of their constitutional authority,” including an amendment to the U.S. Constitution, to reverse the 2010 SCOTUS decision in Citizens United v. FEC, to allow regulation or limitation of campaign contributions and spending, and make clear that corporations should not have the same constitutional rights as human beings.	Support
