<p><b>Note:</b> (3/28/18) In preparation for releasing the delegate vote count list publicly, our staff found a minor anomaly in the system tabulation report and determined that a handful of the more than 32,000 votes that were cast in 12 different statewide races were tabulated erroneously. This review resulted in minor changes to the vote totals that were reported on Sunday at the Convention, but did not affect the outcome of any individual race. The CDP Team is committed to ensuring our members have the most updated and accurate information available. (4/3/18) The CDP has updated the record in 3 races with 4 votes to account for error in tabulation as reported by DSCC members following the release of the vote record. These updates do not affect the outcome in any race.</p>
